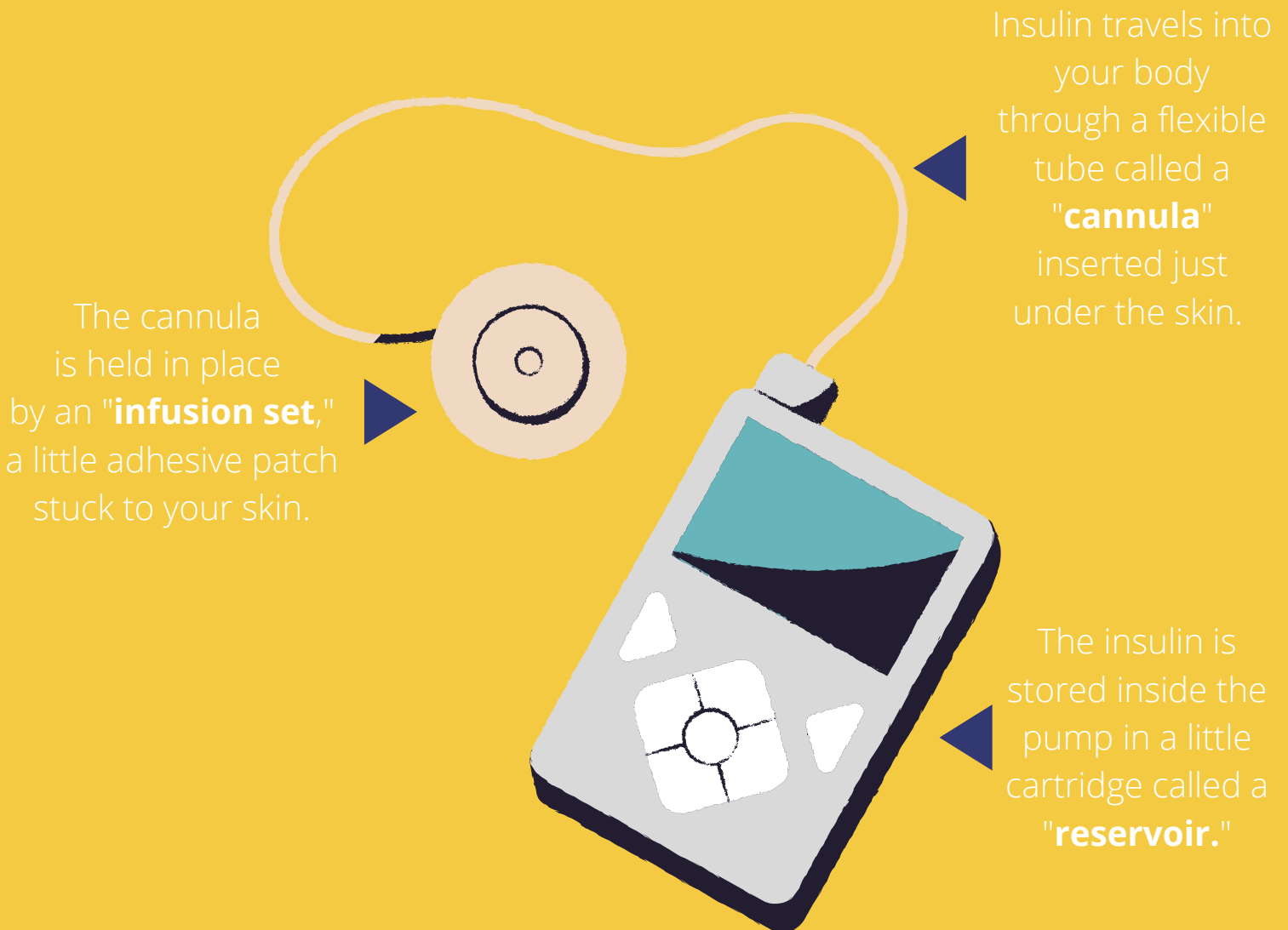


# How an insulin pump works

An insulin pump is a battery-operated device that delivers doses of insulin on a pre-programmed schedule.
